### 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Report, 2018-2019

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Mind is the manifestation of the omnipotent soul. The potential of the mind defies measurement. For the human mind no height is unscalable, no depth is unfathomable, and no region is inaccessible. Everything is possible. Yes, Miss Shruti has proved it in the tenth standard examinations conducted by the CBSE last year. She has broken our Vidyalaya's record by scoring a total of 490 out of 500 marks with two *centums*, one in Mathematics and the other in Sanskrit. Doesn't she deserve rich accolades for her excellent performance?

Though this may not be in good taste, we are proud of Miss Shruti who happens to be the top scorer at the district level in the Board Examination. We make a mention of it here only to enthuse the juniors in the school to step up their pace and strain their nerve to break this record.

On this august occasion, it is in the fitness of things that we share our joy with one and all gathered here, the students and parents, in particular.

Four students, including the school topper, have secured cent per cent in Mathematics and three students in Sanskrit. This is an enviable record the Vidyalaya has created and hence worth remembering.

Closely following Shruti, P.K. Guru Priyaa with 483 marks, Ramalingam Ravindran with 480 marks, K. Keerthana with 479 marks, A. Ganesh and M. Sai Abhishek with 476 marks have registered their remarkable performance in the Board Examinations.

The subject wise toppers:-

S. Shruti : 97% in English,

M.B. Srikaamakshi : 99% in Tamil,

G. Shivosanthosh : 91% in Hindi,

P.K. Guru Priyaa: 98% in Science and

Ramalingam Ravindran : 99% in Social Science.

We are happy to announce that 28 of the 129 students who appeared for the examination, have secured 450 marks and above. And 64 students have scored more than 400 marks.

Our students have made us proud!

I thank the students and the teachers who have worked hard for this success. Hearty congratulations!

The present student-strength of our Vidyalaya is 1445. Because we are rather disinclined to compromise on the infrastructure it is not possible for us to admit as many students as the demand compels. I would like to add that, based on the direction of the CBSE, the intake of students has been considerably reduced. All right-thinking parents would appreciate our stand and understand our problem and bear with the inconvenience.

The attainments of students in the curricular and the co-curricular activities are evaluated continuously throughout their stay in the campus. In recognition of their exemplary academic achievements, pupils attaining the top slot in Stds. 5 to 9 are awarded scholarships for the succeeding year. This scholarship founded two decades ago and later christened '*Shri K.S.Venkataraman Memorial Scholarship*' is dedicated to the memory of the Founder Correspondent of the Vidyalaya.

As usual our students had been taking part zealously throughout the year in the Athletic Meets and tournaments conducted under the auspices of Sahodaya Schools Complex.

Academic exercises and physical activities go hand in hand. Realizing the equal importance to be given to Physical Education, all our teachers extend their total cooperation to the Physical Directors of the school in inculcating in our students the necessary attitude to and aptitude for Physical health which helps build mental health.

Physical Education Training is given on a regular basis to enable the students to compete in various sports activities. The ninth period of the day, between 4.15 p.m. and 5.15 p.m. on all working days, is exclusively set apart for sports and games activities for the students of Stds.6 to 10.

In the current year, the Vidyalaya has two units of scouts with 154 cadets and two units of guides with 174 cadets in addition to the 118 cubs and 87 bulbul.

The cadets are trained for different awards. Chathurth Charan for classes 3 and 4, Golden Arrow for class 5, Pravesh and Pratham for classes 6 and 7, Dwithiya Sopan and Trithiya Sopan for class 8 and the prestigious Rajya Puraskar Award and Rashtrapathi Award for classes 9 and 10.

The number of cadets selected for the year for Rajya Puraskar Award is 70. Of them 43 are from the scouts and 27 are from the guides. 13 cubs and 8 bulbul have been selected for the Golden Arrow Award.

Under the directives of the CBSE, several activities were conducted as part of the regular curriculum. Some of them are:

Prizes are awarded to students for 100% attendance. There are hundreds of students who have attended school without missing even a day, continuously for several years.

The teachers of the Vidyalaya participate regularly in Capacity Building Programmes, Adolescent Education Programmes, O-Lab Training Programme, Gender Sensitivity Programmes, Workshops on Leadership Skills, Motivation and ELT, conducted by empanelled agencies, identified by the CBSE.

In order to help the child to face the multitude of social, interpersonal, physical and emotional problems which need to be resolved, a team of counsellors is at work in the Vidyalaya, with the active participation of parents.

New computers have been acquired to meet the increasing demand. Of the fifty-five computers, twelve have been made available for the exclusive use of the children of the KG classes and Stds. 1 & 2.

On the infrastructural front, steps have been taken to raze down the existing toilet block built in 1975 and to build two new separate toilet blocks, one for the use of boys of Stds. 3 & 4 and the other for the girls of the same classes.

Our alumni meet annually to share their joy of spending time with their classmates on the premises of the Vidyalaya. The atmosphere created in the school is such that they are interested in visiting the campus regularly every year. For the students on roll too, it is an inspiring experience.

To ensure the overall personality development of the students, Yoga and Meditation is made a part of the morning assembly. Bhajans, temple visits and vilakku pooja are organized for the spiritual strengthening and cultural awareness of students.

A good friend to one and all and in particular to the members of the family of the Vidyalaya, Shrimaan G. Ganesa Kutti Sastry is absent today. He had been adorning the stage on all the festive occasions of the Vidyalaya. The gentleman H.M., all of a sudden, joined the majority on the 9<sup>th</sup> of March, 2018. He lived the life of a loveable person to everyone who had acquaintance with him. A simple man, who in the company of friends, laughed and laughed to enliven the group. We miss him, but the memories of his company will last long in the minds of his friends and relatives. We pay our respects to the departed soul.

We have recorded our achievements here! These feats were possible because of the total dedication of the teachers of the institution and the untiring cooperation of the parents in all our endeavors.

Present day youngsters are highly intelligent and are ready to accept challenges. The present day parents too take pride in training their wards in several activities outside the school. It is a welcome measure. But there is a limitation to the mental and physical strength of any human being. Elders should remember that the overall health of the children is important. The technological advancements are no doubt phenomenal. Parents must be wise in taking care to see that their wards avail themselves of the technology, only to their advantage, not otherwise.

In the beginning of the report, we presented our performance in the Board Examinations and we pray the Heavens that the successive batches of students taking the examinations succeed in over shadowing the current record. After all, nothing succeeds like success.
