Institutions are rated on the basis of their performance. Schools are no exception. Unlike in the past, parents and students are eager to know about the schools in their locality to choose the best among them. Infrastructure is a term frequently used to estimate a school. In our opinion, more than all other things, the quality and efficiency of teachers is the most important factor of the infrastructure of an institution. If the teachers perform, the students willingly work hard and the parents extend their cooperation to the system adopted in the school. Consequently, the performance of the students in the Board Examinations will be creditable. When all is said and done, the performance of the students in the examinations of the Board is the acid-test to categorise a school as excellent, good, average or otherwise. The performance of our students in the AISSE of the Board held in March-April, 2019 speaks for itself.

Miss S. Padmashree topped the list of achievers securing 490 marks for a maximum of 500, a performance par excellence. This is not all. 25 other students missed the top slot only by a few marks. Of the 128 students who appeared for the Board Examination held in March-April, 2019, 26 students secured 95% and above, i.e. 475 marks and above. 21 students secured between 450 and 475 marks. Overall, 80 students of the 128 sent up, passed with a distinction of securing 400 marks and above.

The CBSE believes in maintaining high standard in school education. Hence, it is not liberal in awarding the maximum 100 marks to the examinees in the Board Examinations. In such a stiff scenario, twelve of the 128 students, i.e. 10% of them, have secured centum in one subject or the other – two in English, two in Sanskrit, two in Mathematics and six in Social Sciences. Besides these, 18 students have secured 99 marks in different subjects. Honestly, I am proud to convey that our students have aimed high and laboured hard to achieve their highest. Isn't the performance praiseworthy?

How do you estimate the performance of the teachers of the Vidyalaya? Now, don't you think that they deserve a loud applause that would rend the air.

Now, it is your turn to praise the students who made their teachers proud; Reward the achievers with a resounding applause.

With 'Knowledge is Power' as the motto of our school, we have all along been throwing ourselves heart and soul into preparing our students to be self-reliant, knowledgeable and wise. We know only too well the great saint Thiruvallur's dictum which, of course, we practise:

The teachers of the Vidyalaya are encouraged to participate regularly in Capacity Building Programmes, Adolescent Education Programmes, O-Lab Training Programmes, Gender Sensitivity Programmes etc in order to augment their subject knowledge, teaching skills and techniques. Teachers undergo training in Value Education, take part in workshops on Leadership Skills, Motivation and ELT and the like organised through the Centre of Excellence established with the Regional Offices of the CBSE and conducted by various agencies.

The Hubs of Learning Programme suggested by the CBSE is at work and five schools including our Vidyalaya are active in that programme.

To encourage regularity among students, prizes for cent per cent attendance are awarded every year. There are scores of students who have attended school without missing even a day, continuously for several years.

Various activities through different clubs like Consumer Awareness Club, Art and Craft Club, Heritage Club, Quiz Club, Mathematics Club, Eco Club, Swachhta Club, Literary Club and Philately Club are organised to help students to develop their skills and interests in the respective realms.

The alumni of the Vidyalaya meet annually in the campus and acclimatise their juniors here to the contemporary world. They organise an inter school cultural competition titled 'MahotSAV', by way of honing the children to the tenor of the advancing global community.

I assumed office as Principal of the Vidyalaya accepting the baton from Mrs Vasanthi Prakash who demitted office on retirement on the 30<sup>th</sup> of April, 2019.

I humbly submit that I am proud to hold this prestigious office and I seek the support of everyone associated with the Vidyalaya to sustain and improve upon the prestige and popularity our institution has gained in the local community during the last two-score and five years.
