I am pleased and privileged to report to you that the academic year 2022-2023 commenced with a big bang when the CBSE announced the results of the All India Secondary School Examination held in April-May, 2022. Masters G. Arjun, B. Gowtham and G.S. Bhavani Shankar have achieved top honours creating a record of merit by securing 498, 496 and 495 marks respectively for a maximum of 500 marks in the Board Examination. The trio, with their superb achievements have made their parents, teachers and Sri Akilandeswari Vidyalaya proud. They deserve a great applause from you.

Besides, there were 16 centums - 6 in Tamil, 3 in Sanskrit, 1 in English, 3 in Mathematics, 2 in Science and 1 in Social Science. Of the 112 students who were presented for the examination in April-May, 2022, 18 have secured above 475 marks, 22 students above 450 marks and 76 above 400. These students richly deserve recognition and the school is rewarding them with prizes for their excellent performance in the said Board Examination.

Thanks to the whole-hearted hard work of the students, the untiring efforts of the teachers and the unstinted cooperation of the parents, this great achievement has been made possible. This exemplary performance has thrown a challenge to the teachers and the students of the subsequent batches as well. Therefore, more efforts are to be put in both by the teachers and the students to excel this performance. With my team of motivated and professionally competent teachers, I am sure, our students will be groomed for a better and enviable performance in the years to come.

Incidentally, Master G. Arjun, the topper in the said examination, is the grandson of Sriman P. Lakshmi Narayanan a close associate of the Founder-Correspondent Sriman K.S. Venkataraman.

The goal of the Vidyalaya is not to simply prepare the students for academic achievements only. It is to prepare our students to make them God-fearing and patriotic young-men and ladies to be useful to themselves, to their families and to the society at large.

To encourage regularity among students, prizes for cent per cent attendance are awarded every year.

Various activities through different clubs like Consumer Awareness Club, Art and Craft Club, Heritage Club, Quiz Club, Mathematics Club, Eco Club, Swachhata Club, Literary Club and Philately Club are organised to help students to develop their skills and interests in the respective realms.

Like a mother elephant, we try all methods and visit all venues to prepare our students in basic skills and one such avenue is the Khan Academy which helps the young minds to master arithmetic knowledge and self-learning ability. At present, the students of classes 6, 7 and 8 are the beneficiaries of the scheme. We are grateful to the efforts of Shri Thiagarajan of the U.S.A. who spent his time to acquaint us with the products of the Khan Academy and prepare our teachers to adopt themselves to the system.

The record of attainments briefed above is a testimonial to our students' ability to overcome the two-year dormancy and keep themselves on track. Our teachers whole-heartedly strive hard to train our students in co-curricular activities and to take them to the summit of success keeping aloft the flag of SAV.

The alumni of the Vidyalaya meet annually in the campus and acclimatise their juniors here to the contemporary world. They organise an inter school cultural competition titled 'MahotSAV', by way of honing the children to the tenor of the advancing global community.

I would like to place on record the sincere and faithful services of Smt. R. Pirabavathy and Shri K. Thangavelu who are not with us today. The good God has plucked them away prematurely.
